

Application Materials Checklist

Master of Science in Criminal Justice (MSCJ) Application Deadline:

Fall Semester – July 1; Spring Semester – November 1

All materials not submitted electronically should be placed together in a packet and submitted by mail or in person at one time to the Graduate Admissions Office. Please leave sealed items in their original envelopes when putting them in the packet.

1	Online Graduate Application: There is a non-refundable \$60 application fee. https://www.kennesaw.edu/admissions/graduate/application-process/index.php
2	Transcripts – Official transcripts from EACH College and/or University you have attended. Must be in sealed envelope from the institution.
3	Letter of Interest – Can be uploaded into the online application. Should state your interest in and goals for the MSCJ program, including reasons for why/how this program will meet your professional or academic needs (Note: If the applicant has a record of work experience in the criminal justice field, the applicant should explain in the letter the type and length of the experience, his or her work-related promotions and achievements, and skills/knowledge acquired.)
4	Two (2) Letters of Recommendation (should be from academics). (Note: One letter could be from a work supervisor if the applicant has numerous years of work experience in criminal justice field). Can be sent electronically through the online application.
5	Resume - Can be uploaded into the online application.
6	***GRE Score Report – Request that your scores be sent electronically to KSU (school code 5359). No department code is necessary. Minimum score of 286 on the current scale and 800 on the prior scale (Verbal and Quantitative combined).
	***Important Note: GRE Score Report NOT needed if applicant has one of the following other records of external validation: (1) Record of successful academic performance such as undergraduate GPA of 3.25 or above; *OR* (2) Demonstrated record of successful work experience in the criminal justice field for a period of four (4) or more years. [For examples of qualifying types of work experience, see "Admissions Criteria" document on MSCJ website.]
