# Instructions for Senior Capstone Experience Application

All PSYC majors planning to enroll in their Capstone experience in an upcoming semester should submit the Senior Capstone Experience Application prior to registration for that semester. This allows the department to verify that the prerequisites for the Capstone experience have been or will be met by the intended semester and also allows for the department to notify the student of their eligibility so any schedule adjustments can be made as applicable.

\*\*Be sure to select the application that matches the catalog year you are under. The prerequisite requirements for capstone differ depending on catalog year. Your catalog year can be found on your DegreeWorks page in Owl Express.\*\*

## Information for Page 1:

Fill out the indicated required fields and select which option of the Capstone experience you are interested in registering for. You may select more than one. This allows us to verify that you are eligible to register or apply for the option(s) you are interested in.

## Information for Page 2:

The fields on this page are listed as "optional" except for the signature and date, <u>however</u>, when submitting the application, it is important that you input the information requested regarding the prerequisites. The fields are marked as optional because there are areas which only require one course option to be completed. We encourage you to reference your DegreeWorks page when filling out this information.

If the course is one that you either are "in progress" with or one that you plan to register for in an upcoming semester, you can do the following:

- For "in progress" enter the appropriate semester and "I/P" for the grade
- For a course you plan to register for enter the semester you plan to complete the course and leave the grade field blank.

Once the application is completed in its entirety (including student acknowledgement), the form will automatically be submitted to the department for review.
