\* The Department Awards Committee will review application materials and forward the name and application materials of the departmental award winner to RCHSS by the college deadline. For award consideration at the department level, applicants must follow the nomination guidelines provided by the university. The RCHSS Faculty Awards Committee will select the college award winners. All departmental award winners will be nominated by the Dean for the KSU award in the same category.

\*\* At this time, there is only a Regents' award in this category (no Department, College, or KSU awards). The university only requires a one-page nominating statement during the initial phase of review. Only recipients of the university-level KSU nominations for the Regents' awards will submit full application packets. CETL assists with preparation of the full application packets. Departments will submit up to three applications to the RCHSS Faculty Awards Committee. The RCHSS Faculty Awards Committee will submit the rank-ordered top five applications to the Dean.

\*\*\* The Regents' Teaching Excellence Awards for Department or Program, the Regents' Momentum Year Award for Excellence in Advising and Student Success, and the Regents' Momentum Year Award for Excellence in Teaching and Curricular Innovation are not faculty-awards but **Program-based** awards. In the past, few colleges have submitted nominations in these categories to the KSU review committee. Departments are encouraged to submit nominations in these categories, keeping in mind that the BOR pays special attention to programs that can demonstrate improvement and success over several years, supported by data. The university only requires a one-page nominating statement during the initial phase of review. Only recipients of the university-level KSU nominations for the Regents' awards will submit full application packets. CETL assists with preparation of the full application packets.
